

Vancouver Solid American Oak Furniture Care Sheet

Please read carefully to understand how to care for your Solid Oak Furniture

Our Vancouver Furniture Range is handmade from solid American Oak in an oiled wax finish. The natural characteristics of this solid oak furniture range may include small cracks, knots and grain pattern variations which all add to the natural charm and beauty of these products.

All of our Vancouver tables are designed with a floating joint system which can be seen in the purpose built gaps around the edges of the table top panels. These gaps allow the wood to expand and contract freely in line with seasonal variation of temperature and humidity in a central heated UK home. It is normal for these joints to expand and close by up to 3mm at different times of the year.

Care and Maintenance of your Solid Oak Furniture

- Avoid keeping your furniture too close to radiators or other heat sources as extreme variations in temperature can cause slight movements in the furniture's structure.
- We recommend that you apply a bees wax product once or twice a year to seal and polish the surface and to fill any cracking that may appear as part of the natural ageing process of oak. Scratches to the furniture may also be fixed using an oak coloured bees wax.
- Any spillages should be wiped up immediately with a clean dry lint free cloth to avoid marking the surface of the furniture.
- When assembling or moving your furniture, please avoid dragging it as this may cause damage to the frame and joints and to your floor.
- Try to avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight as this may alter the colour and tone of your solid oak product over time.
- Avoid contact with warm objects such as hot cups and plates. Always use coasters and table mats to protect the surface of your oak furniture.

If you follow these simple guidelines your solid oak furniture should last a lifetime. Thank you for your business.
