Please read carefully to understand how to care for your Vancouver American Oak Furniture

Our Country Oak Furniture Range is handmade from American Oak with an oiled wax finish. The natural characteristics of this oak furniture range may include small cracks, knots, blemishes and grain pattern variations which all add to the natural charm and beauty of these furniture products. Expansion gaps may appear around the table top sections over time as the table adjusts to the warmer conditions inside your home. This is perfectly normal and not a sign of a faulty table. If you are looking for a flawless even table top finish then the Country oak range might not be the best design to go for and we can offer the Provence cross leg range as an alternative which has a very uniform and clean finish across the table top and is made from European oak.

Care and Maintenance of your Country Oak Furniture

- Avoid keeping your furniture too close to radiators or other heat sources as extreme variations in temperature can cause slight movements in the furniture's structure.
- We recommend that you apply a good quality furniture bees wax such as Bri Wax once or twice a year to seal and polish the surface and to fill any minor cracking that may appear as part of the natural ageing process of oak. Scratches to the furniture may also be repaired using an oak coloured bee's wax or wax filler sticks.
- Any spillages should be wiped up immediately with a clean dry lint free cloth to avoid marking the surface of the furniture.
- When assembling or moving your furniture, please avoid dragging it as this may cause damage to the frame and joints and to your floor.
- Try to avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight as this may alter the colour and tone of your oak furniture over time.
- Avoid contact with warm objects such as hot cups and plates. Always use coasters and table mats to protect the surface of your oak furniture.

If you follow these simple guidelines your Country oak furniture should last a lifetime. Thank you for your business.
